I am asking all the Sectional FCF Reps and Commanders to get the word out to their section that the applications <u>must be</u> reviewed for completeness by the Sectional FCF Rep prior to sending them to me. All new member applications are due to me with a \$25 dollar deposit no later than **April 1**st. Make checks payable to NJMN and put FCF in the memo line. After they are reviewed and accepted, I will send a letter which they **"MUST"** read very carefully. The remaining \$25 will be due at the Trace. Remember <u>ALL</u> attendees 18 and older must have their Pastor sign off on either the application (candidates) or the dues and registration form (current members). Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
